In 2016, the engineering company Aecom were appointed as design consultants on the feasibility study for this project, first proposed by Cllr Smyth shortly after he was elected. This is the first step in providing a route across the constituency for school children to walk/cycle to and from school via quiet, residential streets through the use of “Filtered Permeability” i.e. creating a series of vehicular cul de sacs across the city which you can still walk or cycle through without competing with commuters, busses or trucks. It will also significantly decrease the number of ‘Rat-Runs’ available to commuters traversing the constituency.

Phase One of the project will run from Terenure to Ballsbridge where it will join the Dodder Greenway at Herbert Park.

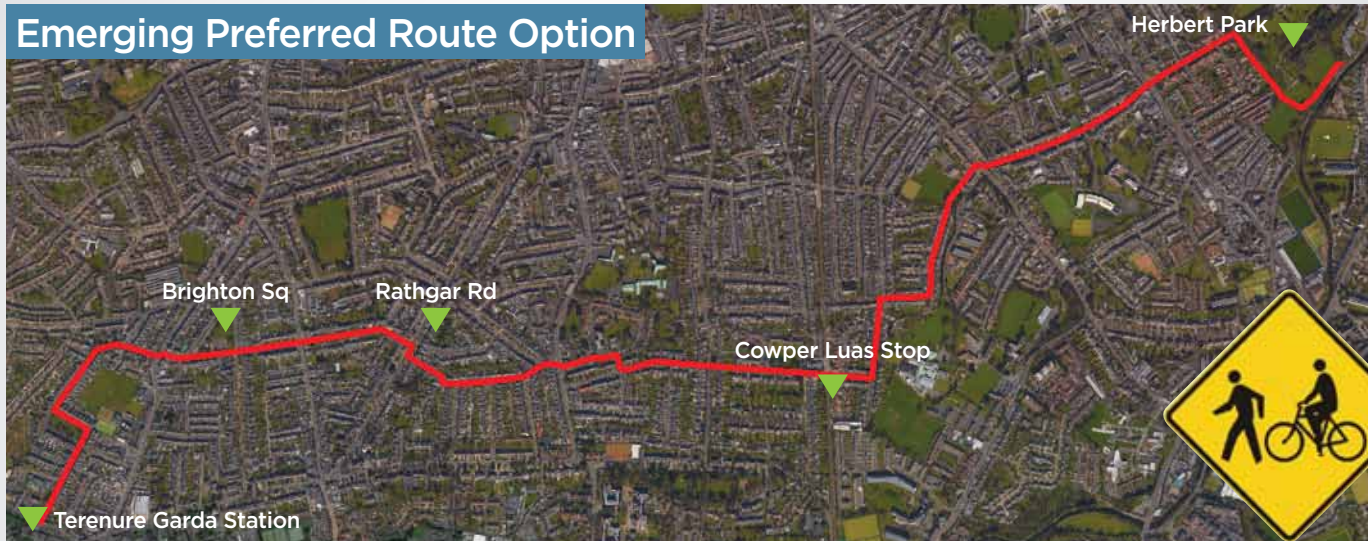
